Details of the Training Course

Background of Course

Ayurveda as an emerging field in health care may sound paradoxical but it is true. It is a fact that Ayurveda is a millennia-old system of health care. But the gap in practice and knowledge that came during the last 4 to 5 centuries, particularly during the British rule had pushed Ayurveda to run behind the time. Thus, the continuous development and enrichment of Ayurveda was halted and that rendered its practices and understanding to be incomprehensible to the larger population. But all and sundry accept that Ayurveda is needed for the world. Therefore, Ayurveda has become the emerging field in health care as its principles and practices need contemporary understanding. There is need of hour to develop some skilled manpower that produces quality human resource which help Ayurvedic practitioners, so that they can better contribute in health system of society. In the view of skill India programme institute has proposed a short term training course in Kshara karma technician.

Introduction of course

In astanga Ayurveda Shalya Tantra is very important branch, various surgical principal described by Sushruta are well established and current medical system has followed it with little modification or as such. There are some para surgical procedures like Agnikarma (Thermal cautery), Kshara Karma Therapy (Caustic therapy), Shiravedha (Venepuncture) and Leech therapy described by Sushruta. Kshara karma therapy is on of the effective, having very significant effect in few chronic disorders like haemorrhoids, fistula-in-ano, fissure-in-

ano, Pilonidal sinus and Chronic non-healing wounds where modern surgical procedures has high chances of fail or recurrence.

Kshara is a caustic, alkaline in nature obtained from the ashes of medicinal plants. It is a milder procedure compared to surgery and thermal cautery. It is the superior most among the sharp and subsidiary instruments because of performing excision, incision and scraping. It is versatile, because even such places that are difficult in approach by ordinary measures can be treated by Kshara Karma. Kshara Karma is useful as the substitute of surgical instruments, because they can be used safely on the patients who are afraid of surgery. On the basis of Administration kshara karma therapy is of two types as Pratisaaraneeya Kshara – External application and Paneeya Kshara - Internal administration. On the basis of Concentration -Mild, Moderate and Highly.

As Kshara karma is minimally invasive technique with minimal requirement of health setups. The procedure can be performed under local anaesthesia so it is cost effective too.

Aim of the course

The objective of this Kshara karma technician course is developed skilled manpower to assists the Ayurvedicsurgeons to work kshara karma as routine procedures in health care setups.

Infrastructure of Institute

North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy (NEIAH), Shillong has Shalya Tantra department with fully equipped kshara karma lab for the training of preparation of the kshara and Kshara sutra. Institute also have Shalya Tantra OPD with good number of patient and IPD service along with working operating theatre for the kshara karma procedure. The trainee will receive training of kshara preparation in department laboratory and hands on training on the patients in hospital.

Number of seats: 20 seats per batch

Mode of training:

Total duration of course is 220 hrs. (45 hrs Classroom teaching and 175 hrs practical training in OPD/IPD) in 90 days.

The total duration is divided in theory and Practical hands-on training equally.

- 1. The classroom training will be provided on online mode for 45 days and Trainee will be encouraged for self-practice/learning in this period.
- 2. Practical training of 45 days will be provided in campus as per course curriculum
