Subject: Guidelines relating to processing and timelines for granting/ renewal of permissions of ASU & H colleges:-

As per the provisions of Establishment of New Medical College, (Opening of New/ Higher Course of Study/ Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a College) Regulations, the applications are received in the month of April and have to be disposed of by 31st March of the subsequent year. However, it has been observed that the present process is cumbersome and time consuming which made it difficult to dispose of application in time. Therefore, in order to streamline the process and time schedule prescribed for dealing with applications received under Section 12A of HCC Act, 1973 /13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 as well as the existing Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H colleges), the Central Government has prescribed the following Guidelines for strict compliance:-

“(i) Guidelines for streamlining the process and timelines for granting/ renewal of permissions of ASU & H colleges

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(ii) The Central Government, after receipt of the applications shall do the preliminary scrutiny of application for basic eligible criteria like Application Fee, No Objection Certificate (NOC) of the State Government, Consent of Affiliation of the University. The Central Government shall forward only those eligible applications to the Councils for further consideration. The in-eligible and incomplete applications shall be rejected and returned to the applicants.

(iii) The Councils shall inspect colleges and issue Letter of Intent (LOI) at their level, if the college is found eligible. The Council shall again inspect/ verify the compliance of the conditions of LOI and send the recommendation of either Denial/ for issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) as the case may be, only once by 31st March for approval of the Ministry.”.

2. CCIM and CCH are requested to strictly comply the directions given above immediately in dealing with all applications forwarded by the Ministry. The Councils are also requested to place the above Guidelines on their respective websites for wider publicity. Further, the Councils may propose appropriate amendments in the concerned Regulations. It may be noted that, till the concerned regulations are amended, these Guidelines shall continue to be in-force.
